### **Stained Glass Door/Windows**

Here's how to create your art:

- Choose elements to use
- Tape design onto window/door
- Paint
- Allow plenty of time to dry
- Remove tape





Here's the approximate cost:

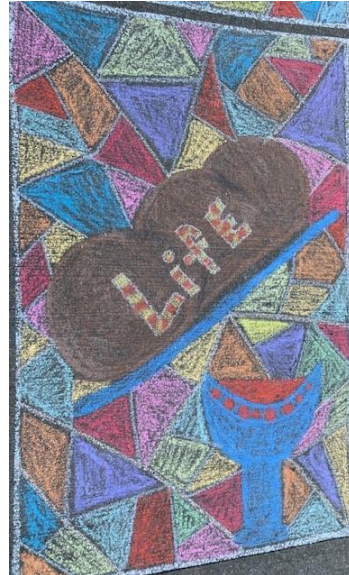
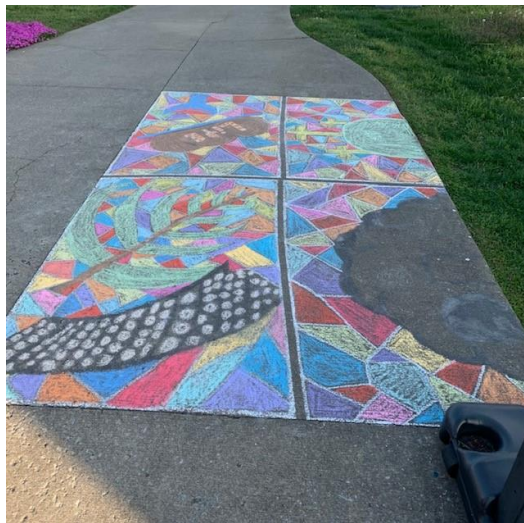
- \$4-5 for washable finger paint
- \$1-2 for sponge paintbrushes
- \$2-4 for painters' tape



## Stained Glass Sidewalk/Driveway Chalk Art

Using the artwork created for the Pentecost Offering by Illustrated Ministry LLC (or a design of your own), you can create a “stained glass” work of art on a sidewalk or driveway. The one we created for OGHS took elements of that piece and were drawn onto driveways.

- Choose elements to use
- Tape design onto sidewalk or driveway
- Apply chalk to design
- Remove tape



Here's the approximate cost:

- \$4-5 for sidewalk chalk
- \$2-4 for painters' tape
